

HTML Elements 2 Webdesign

`` - This tag places an image on your page

`<a>` - anchor tag; this tag adds a link to your page

`<address>` - Specifies an address block within an HTML document, in which the author or owner is identified and a means for feedback is provided.

`<div>` - Defines a document division, which can contain any other “body” elements.

`align attribute` - Used to horizontally align elements on the page (it can be used in the `<h1>`, `<h2>`, `<h3>`, `<h4>`, `<h5>`, `<h6>`, `<p>`, and `<div>` elements).

Link (anchor) examples:

<p>This sentence will appear in the center.</p>
</div>
```

align Examples

```
<p align="left">This is on the left.</p>
<h1 align="center">This is in the center.</h1>
<h2 align="right">This is on the right.</h2>
<p align="justify">This is a long paragraph that will appear justified.</p>
```

Standard Tag (with attribute)

```
<tag attribute="value">Insert text here.</tag>
```

Remember:

- 1) All tags and attributes are always lowercase.
- 2) Attributes only appear in start and empty tags. Attributes NEVER appear in end tags.
